Potential funding opportunities for Active & Healthy Ageing

TODAY



7th Framework Programme (FP7): Total budget € 51 billion. More than € 4 billion available in the last calls (July 2012) potentially relevant for societal challenge such as ageing and/or EIP priorities.



Competitiveness and Innovation Framework Programme (CIP): Total Budget € 3,6 billion. ICT part of CIP has allocated €24 Million in the Work Programme 2012 for actions directly relevant for the EIP.



Second Health Programmes: Total budget 321 million. In the last call (closed in March) € 4 million for the EIP on AHA.
